Customer challenges and requirements

When the site opened in 2020, the Bazaar inherited multifunction devices, print management tools via a server, together with their operational processes from the former parent company, to provide self-service printing services to approximately 350 people using the co-working space. In order to access printing services, users had to email the administrator with information required to create an account. The administrator then had to create accounts manually; with frequent changes of user, this was tedious and time-consuming.



The solution

Canon proposed that the server hosted software be moved to a cloud solution - uniFLOW Online -which offers the same level of printing services for end users, including secure printing with my print anywhere, mobile printing and scanning to myself. It also simplifies the creation of users; the implementation of self-enrolment is much quicker and does not need any third-party involvement.
